How to join & membership fee

It's as simple as 123. First, visit the Club Bar, on your own or with a member. Secondly, complete an application form for membership available from the Bar Manager. Your application then is considered by the Committee at the next earliest opportunity. Thirdly, you will receive confirmation from our membership secretary that your application has been accepted. You can visit the Club whilst waiting for membership.

The main requirement for membership is that you will visit the club at a time which suits you and that you will be pleasant company. We currently have around 200 members and there is no waiting list.

Adult membership costs £7 per year, no joining fee.

This is outrageously low (work out pub prices and see how soon you will save money). E.G. our real ales - £2.25 per pint.

Junior membership costs £3 per year. Parents please note - we do not serve alcohol to those who are, or appear to be, underage.

Benefits of membership

All of the events and activities are organised for the enjoyment of members. The Club and all it's stock of drinks etc. are bought on behalf of the members. Our bar prices are low, and whilst we aim to make a profit, this is balanced with the need to ensure the long term viability of the Club along with providing functions and entertainment at a cost which is affordable to members. We aim to provide a venue which promotes good fellowship for the people of this village and visitors alike. We have members from all walks of life, with a variety of interests. We are always interested in accepting new members to add to the character of this part of village life. Along with other licensed premises, we are now a completely non-smoking club. So if you have visited previously and found things a little smokey don't worry, things have changed.

We are also keen to have members who wish to contribute to the running of the club, either by standing for committee membership, or by simply wishing to put on events.
